The valley derives its name from the spectacular red sandstone formations created from great shifting sand dunes during the age of dinosaurs. See the many unique shapes that were formed by mother nature and notice how the rocks appear to be on fire when reflecting the sun's rays. A true natural wonder! Marvel at early man that is represented throughout the park by 3,000 year-old Indian petroglyphs. Enjoy an **included picnic lunch** in the park. We return to our departure points this evening with the colorful hues of Utah's Color Country forever ingrained in our minds. (Breakfast, Lunch)
