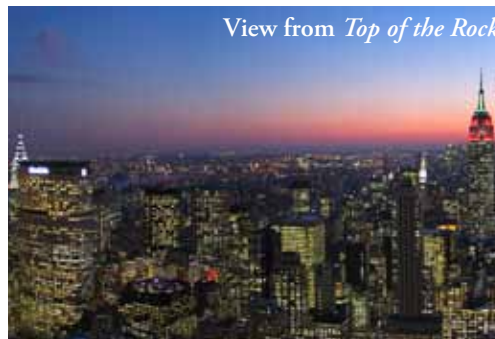

TRAVEL PROTECTION / CANCELLATION

Letterman. Visit **Central Park** and **Strawberry Fields** – the tribute to the late John Lennon by his wife Yoko Ono. See the **Lincoln Center**, **Carnegie Hall**, the **Plaza Hotel**, **Columbia University**, the **Cathedral of St. John the Divine**, **Harlem**, the **Metropolitan Museum of Art**, the **Guggenheim Museum**, the **Frick Museum** and the celebrity estates along Central Park East and West, and drive through **Harlem**. This afternoon is free for you take in the city at leisure. Perhaps a horse-drawn carriage ride around Central Park? This evening, a farewell dinner at a local favorite.
